

Create multiple criterion, using a rubric score for class discussions. Student scores can be recorded during the class activity or presentation.


Use the <u>Item Analysis Report</u> to review skills and areas of improvement.

Track and score multiple components of a project. Edit the item title to indicate the project element. Each category may be assigned different max points.


Provide <u>Feedback</u> for specific components, viewable in the Student Portal.
